The youngest audiences, and their parents, will enjoy StoryBook Theater's 55-minute, fun-loving musical adaptation of **Rapunzel**. For older audiences, Studio East presents **Into the Woods**, the Tony award-winning fairy tale epic. And finally, the whole family will enjoy the musical comedy, **Hello, Mrs. Piggle Wiggle!**, based on the classic children's books by Betty MacDonald.

StoryBook Theater is closing out its 20th season with a favorite of many young audience members, **Rapunzel**. The hair-oine in this story has big dreams, and neither her long, rainbow locks of hair nor large locks on towers will keep her from chasing after them. Full of audience interaction and catchy tunes, this 55-minute musical is perfect for theater goers ages 3+.

In March, Studio East will put on *Into the Woods*, the lively, irreverent fantasy musical that combines all of your favorite fairy tales. When a Baker and his Wife learn they've been cursed with childlessness by the Witch next door, they embark on a quest required to break the spell. Packed with vibrant characters including Cinderella, Little Red, Jack and Rapunzel, this musical will have you on the edge of your seat.

The show is recommended for ages 9+ and has a running time of approximately 2 hours with intermission. Adult tickets are \$19, students and seniors are \$17, and gala tickets are \$22. All shows are performed by student casts at the Studio East Mainstage Theater, located at 11730 118th Ave NE in Kirkland. Performances run March 16 – March 31, with performances on Fridays at 7:30pm, Saturdays at 2:30pm and 7:30pm, and Sundays at 2:30pm. In the spring, the silly, imaginative Mrs. Piggle Wiggle will take the Studio Mainstage. *Hello, Mrs. Piggle Wiggle!* is based on the hilarious, magical stories of Mrs. Piggle Wiggle, her upside down house, her pirate husband, and her parrot, Penelope. Full of rousing song and dance numbers, parents and children alike will appreciate the comedy and music.
